# **Getting to the Clinic**

Clinic Address and Location

Directions to the Clinic:

- 1. Take the Health Care Centre 'Green Zone' elevators to the basement level
- 2. Turn right off the elevator.
- 3. Follow the Green Line on the floor and the signs for the "CARE Clinic".
- 4. Enter through the CARE Clinic doors at the end of the hall.

## Parking and Transit

Limited parking is available at the hospital on the Sherbrooke Lot.

Street parking is available on Sherbrooke and Keary Street. Parking is metered so you will need enough coins or a credit card.

The Sapperton SkyTrain Station is located close to the Keary Street entrances of hospital.

### What to expect at your visit

- This is not a class but an assessment appointment with a Neurologist and other members of the Stroke team.
- Plan to be here for up to 3 hours. Please keep this in mind when you pay for parking.
- Please note your appointment time is the time you are to check in at the Clinic. How long you wait to see a member of the Stroke team can vary.
- We suggest you bring something to read or do while you wait.

### After your visit

- The Neurologist might want you to go for added medical tests. Please make sure you tell the Neurologist if you are planning to leave the country or go out of town for longer than 3 weeks in the near future.
- We send a copy of your consultation/visit letter to your family doctor. It can take 3 to 6 weeks for your family doctor to receive all your results and visit letter.
- If you have any Disability Forms or other insurance related forms to be filled out, please contact your family doctor's office.
