

Are Your Child's Immunizations Up-to-Date?

Check your child's immunization records one of these ways:

- Scanning this QR code
- Going online to <u>HealthGateway.gov.bc.ca</u>
- Using the Health Gateway app

Records for children under 12 years old are on their parent's account. Children 12 years and older need to log in to their own accounts to see their records.

If your child needs an immunization:

Make an appointment at your local public health unit, family doctor, or local pharmacy. For a list of pharmacies offering immunizations, scan this QR code or go to <u>FraserHealth.ca/howtogetimmunized</u>.

If the immunization record is missing immunizations that your child received:

Contact the health care provider who gave the immunizations. Ask for a copy of the immunization record.

Once you have a copy, report these immunizations to Public Health online by either scanning this QR code or going to <u>FraserHealth.ca/immunizationform</u>. When Public Health receives it from you, they will add it to your child's immunization records.
