Community Care Services

Community Care services are meant to *supplement* rather than replace the efforts of people to care for themselves with the help and support of family, friends, and neighbours.

Eligibility for Community Care services varies. You might need to pay for services depending on your income.

Please note: Community Care services do not include:

- -housekeeping
- -transportation
- -snow removal

Important: Pets and Smoking, Vapour and Tobacco policies

Fraser Health has a Pet policy and Smoke, Vapour and Tobacco policy to keep staff safe while providing care in your home

We review these policies with you before your first home visit.

Pets must be secured while staff are in your home.

Please do not smoke or vape in your home 1 hour before your visit and while we are at your home.

Not following these policies could affect your services.

The following briefly describes Home Health services.

Community Health Nurses

Our nurses work with you to create your plan of care and help you stay safe at home. The nurse sees you in a clinic setting or in your home.

Community Health nurses work with you to develop your health plan so you can live at home for as long as possible, by determining the type of care and support needed to help you stay at home safely.

Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy

Therapists teach you how to improve and/or maintain your physical health and your ability to do every day activities.

Therapists assess and treat you at home when you are not mobile enough to go to a Community Clinic.

Health Services for Community Living

A program available to developmentally delayed adults with medical conditions who need added support so they can be as healthy as possible.

Clients are referred to this program through Community Living BC Services.

Social Work

Social Workers can help with safety and risk concerns, personal distress, and system navigation. They can also give information on financial programs and community resources such as housing options. Social workers support and protection vulnerable adults.

For clients, it offers therapeutic activities, health monitoring, help with toileting, and lunch. Each client has an individual plan of care that helps to maximize physical, mental, and social functioning.

For caregivers, the program offers support and respite.

Who can take part in this program?

To take part in this program, the older adult must already be a client of one of our Community Care professionals.

It is meant for frail older adult clients who live at home and are experiencing the challenges of aging along with an illness and/or chronic disease.
