

Getting Tested for COVID-19

Public Health recommends COVID-19 testing for anyone with symptoms of the flu (influenza) or COVID-19.



If you have no symptoms, you do not need to have a test unless Public Health directs you to be tested.

If you are not sure whether to seek medical care or to be tested, here are your options:

- Contact your family doctor.
- Call the Fraser Health Virtual Care team.
