

COVID-19 Testing Before Surgery



Everyone having scheduled elective surgery **must be tested for COVID-19** before surgery.

For your health and the safety of our staff:

- ➔ 3 to 4 days before your surgery, get tested for COVID-19.
- ➔ Stay physically distant from others for 14 days before surgery (or as long as possible, if surgery is less than 14 days away).
- ➔ Contact your surgeon if your health changes and you become ill.

Where to get a COVID-19 test
