

Getting Ready for Your C-Section

Maternity Unit - Level 3, Peace Arch Hospital

Prevent your C-section from being delayed

- Complete all of your blood tests at Peace Arch Hospital lab, 24 to 72 hours before your surgery.
- **Do not eat any food** after 12:00 midnight the night before surgery.
- **3 hours before** surgery, you may drink 1 ½ cup (350 mL) of clear apple juice. Please do not drink any other kind of juice. After this, do not drink anything.

Use this checklist to help you prepare for your surgery	
Two (2) weeks before your surgery ☐ Go to www.fraserhealth.ca/labs to make an appointment at Peach Arch Hospital for blood tests. The lab will have your requisition form. ☐ Let your surgeon know if you have had any recent health changes since your last visit.	 ☐ If you take blood thinners, ask your surgeon when to stop taking them. ☐ If you take diabetes medicine, ask your surgeon how to take it before surgery.
 One (1) week before your surgery Stop taking herbal supplements such as garlic, gingko, kava, St. John's Wort, ginseng, don quai, and glucosamine. Continue to take your prescribed medicines and prenatal vitamins. 	 Stop any shaving, waxing, threading, or using any other method of removing hair from the area where you are having surgery. Buy 4% Chlorhexidine Gluconate sponges (buy 2) or liquid soap (enough for 2 showers) from a drugstore (Ask the pharmacist).
 The night before your surgery ☐ Remove all: makeup jewellery including face, ears, tongue, or other body piercings Do not eat any food after 12:00 midnight. You may drink clear fluids such as water or apple juice until 3 hours before your surgery. 	 □ Take a shower. ■ Wash your hair with regular shampoo and your face with mild soap ■ Clean your body from the neck to your toes (front and back) using the Chlorhexidine Gluconate sponges or liquid soap. ■ Rinse well. Dry off with a clean towel. □ Do not put on any lotion, perfume or cologne, deodorant, or make-up.
	☐ Put on clean pyjamas. Sleep in clean sheets.

Getting Ready for Your C-Section - continued The morning of your surgery Shower again **3 hours before** your surgery, you may Use the Chlorhexidine Gluconate drink 1 ½ cups (350 ml) of apple juice. After this, do not drink anything. sponges or liquid soap. If you have diabetes, follow any special Rinse well. instructions given to you for eating, drinking, Dry off with a clean towel. and taking your diabetes medications. **Do not** put on any lotion, perfume or cologne, deodorant, or make-up. Take all your regular morning medicines with a small sip of water as directed by your surgeon Brush your teeth, tongue, and and/or anesthesiologist. roof of mouth. ☐ Dress in clean comfortable clothes. Wear your glasses, hearing aids, and/or dentures if you have them. No contact lenses. What to bring with you Personal belongings such as toiletries, slippers, A list of the medicines you take and loose fitting clothing Your BC Services Card Optional: a device for taking pictures Photo identification Note: We do not allow video recording in the Laboratory identification wristband (if given one) operating room An infant car seat and clothing for baby Leave jewellery and other valuables at home. A nurse from our Maternity Unit calls you 1 week before your C-section date. At 2 pm or later on the day before your surgery (or Friday if your surgery is the following Monday), your surgeon's office will contact you. They will tell you what time to arrive at the hospital. Keep this sheet close to the phone so you can write down this information.
