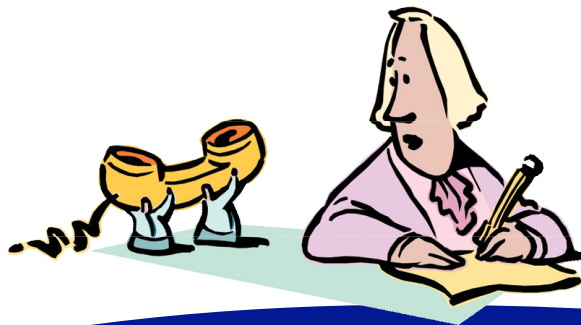
Be Prepared...



- ✓ Know your medical and surgical history.
- ✓ Know your kidney and family doctor.
- ✓ Wear a medic alert bracelet.

- ✓ Carry a list of your medications at all times and take all of your medications with you.

- ✓ Phone your Kidney Dialysis Unit and let them know you are going to Emergency.



When you get to the Hospital...

- ✓ Tell the Emergency staff that you are a Kidney patient.

- ✓ **NO** IVs, blood work or blood pressures on your **ACCESS**

Blood Work

- ✓ Tell the staff not to give you any extra fluids or IVs as you have a fluid restriction.

What happens if I get admitted to the Hospital?

- ✓ You will be dialyzing at the Hospital Dialysis Unit.
- ✓ Your dialysis schedule may change.
- ✓ Cancel your Handidart.

When you have been Discharged...

- ✓ Have a plan for getting home – you shouldn't drive.
- ✓ Phone your Kidney Dialysis Unit and tell them you have been discharged.

- ✓ Plan for transportation to the Hospital Kidney Dialysis Unit.

- ✓ Bring your list of medications and all of your medications to the Kidney Dialysis Unit – there may have been changes.



- ✓ Phone to restart Handidart.
