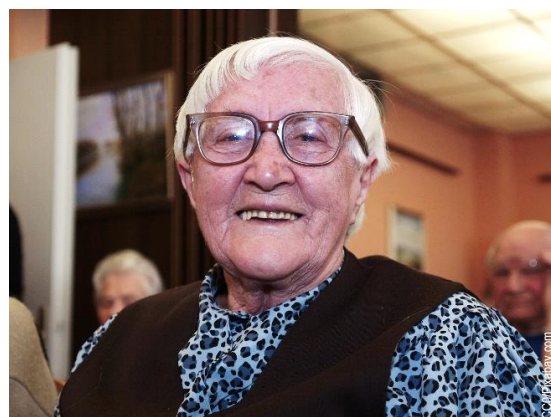
Health Care Support Workers

Added support in Long-Term Care and Assisted Living settings

What is happening?

We are adding health care support workers to our team!

These people are in training to become health care assistants. While in training, they are working here as health care support workers.



What does a health care support worker do?

Your care team supervises the health care support workers.

While they do not provide any hands-on care, they can do the following:

- ✓ Prepare snacks or warm up meals.
- ✓ Make beds.
- ✓ Provide light housekeeping such as changing the sheets on your bed.
- ✓ Set up selected equipment.
- ✓ Help with recreation activities.
- ✓ Spend time with residents.

How might this affect you?

You might see and meet new health care support workers in the building. These added workers allow us to spend more time with you.
