Although this was a difficult time for us the hospice staff and volunteers made us feel very comfortable and at ease. They took very good care of my father. They treated him with dignity and respect, like their own father. They gave comfort to our family when we were in need to talk to someone, or just to sit next to us in silence holding our hands.

What is a hospice?

- A home like setting that provides comfort care for people who are in their last weeks or months of life.
- Care is focused on the quality of life. Treatment focus is pain and symptom management.





How is a hospice different from other care settings?

At hospice:

- Visiting hours are flexible
- Visitors can stay overnight
- Pets can visit during the day
- Family/Friends can bring food
- Access to virtual visits





Who can be admitted to hospice?

For admission to hospice a person must:

- * Have care needs that cannot be supported at home or long term care
- * Have a life expectancy of weeks to months
- Agree to Medical Orders for Scope of Treatment (MOST) M1 or M2



Which hospice will I go to?

The palliative care consultation team, through discussions with you, your family, friends and your physician, help identify the most appropriate hospice location.

Who provides the care?



In addition to the palliative physician and nursing support on-site, the hospice also provides patients with access to social workers, spiritual practitioner, hospice volunteers, translator and pharmacy services.

- * Focuses on physical, psychological, social, and spiritual needs
- \chi Identifies what is important to you
- * Helps achieve your end of life wishes
