## How to collect a stool sample

- ☑ Culture and Sensitivity
- ☑ Stool for electrolytes, pH, fat, porphryins

## What you need

- A clean empty plastic food container, or
- Plastic wrap



## What we give you

- Sterile sample container
- One wooden stick
- Biohazard specimen bag

## To collect a sample

- 1. Write your full name and date of birth on each sample container.
- 2. Urinate (go pee) first then get ready to collect your stool sample.
- 3. Catch some stool while you have a bowel movement (going poop) by:
  - Holding the empty plastic food container under your bottom,
     or
  - Placing plastic wrap over the rim of the toilet.
- 4. Right after you collect the sample, use the wooden stick to put some of the stool in the sample containers.
  - Sterile sample container Fill the container with about one tablespoon (or the size of a walnut).
- 5. Tighten the lid on the container.
- 6. Place the remaining stool sample in the toilet. Put anything you used to collect the sample in a plastic bag and put it in the garbage.
- 7. Wash your hands with soap and water.
- 8. Write the date and time of collection on the sample containers.
- 9. Place the sample containers in the biohazard bag.
- 10. Return the sample to the laboratory within 2 hours.

Try not to catch any urine while catching the stool sample.

**Do not** take the stool sample from the toilet bowl or let the sample touch the inside of the toilet.

Can't get to the laboratory within 2 hours?
Keep in fridge. Bring them in as soon as possible.
