

## Immunization status: Grade 9 international students

Dear Student/Parent/Guardian/Representative,

As part of British Columbia's immunization program, Fraser Health provides vaccines at school to Grade 9 international students when both of these situations apply:

- The student is living in British Columbia for 6 months or more during the school year.
- The student is enrolled in a public or independent school.

If the student is living in British Columbia for less than 6 months, they can get free vaccines through Public Health, family doctors, nurse practitioners, or pharmacies.

Note: Not all family doctors, nurse practitioners, or pharmacies offer vaccines. Make sure to call ahead and check.
