

After your procedure

- You may feel:
 - Numbness
 - Weakness
 - An odd feeling in the area that was treated
- You may not feel any difference.
- You may, or may not, obtain pain relief in the first few hours after the injection.

When you go home

- Take it easy for the rest of the day.
- Do not drive for rest of the day.
- Complete the response diary.
- Continue with your usual medication.
- Follow up in the pain clinic in 2 to 4 weeks.

If you received sedation

- Read the patient information pamphlet for 'Procedural Sedation'.
