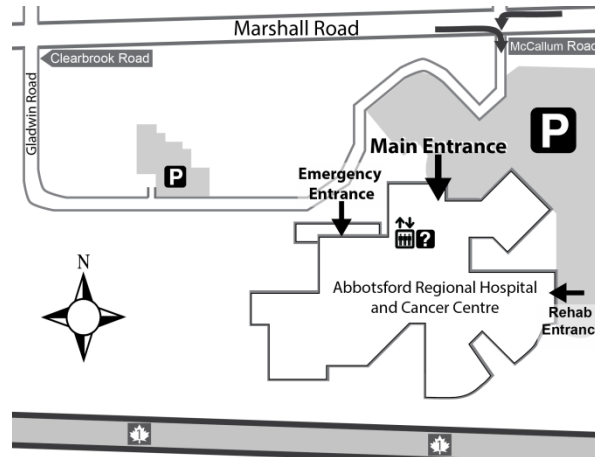
Call as soon as possible. We will reschedule your appointment.

Unit clerk

- ✓ Arranges your clinic appointments.

Nurse

Social Worker

- ✓ Helps you with treatment decisions and health care planning.
- ✓ Provides counselling and referrals to community resources.

Dietitian

- ✓ Monitors your blood test results and provides nutrition education.

Nephrologist (Kidney Doctor)

- ✓ Reviews the medical issues and medications related to your kidney care.

- ✓ Actively take part in your health care with the kidney care team

Forms

- ✓ Complete and bring the forms we sent you.

Medications

- ✓ Bring all the medications, vitamins, and herbal supplements you are currently taking.

Blood Tests
