

Medical Assistance in Dying - The Process

These are the steps in the Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) process.

The process is slightly different depending on whether death is expected in the near future or not.

Step 1:

- ☐ Complete the **MAiD Request form** (Form 1632).

- ☐ Send the completed form to our MAiD Care Coordination Centre. We will contact you to talk about next steps.

Step 2:

a) Death is expected soon

There is no waiting period.

b) Death is not expected soon

There is a 90-day waiting period before MAiD can happen. It starts from the date of #1 medical assessment. An expert in your illness must be consulted before MAiD is approved.

Step 3:

- ☐ Both assessors agree you are eligible for MAiD.
- ☐ Contact our MAiD Care Coordination Centre when you are ready to set a date for your assisted death.
