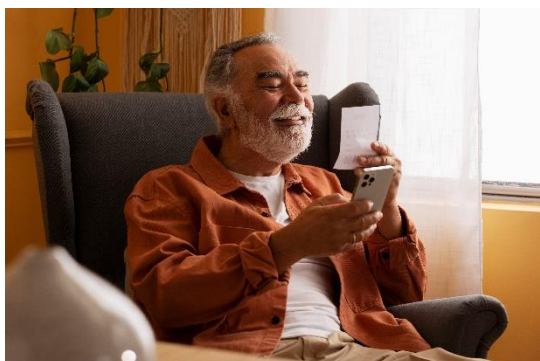

The Program

To support resident health and well-being, Fraser Heath Assisted Living Services is partnering with your care community to offer **on-site family doctor services**.



Your on-site doctor can work with your care team, including on-site nurses and pharmacists to support your needs in a timely and supportive manner.

The on-site doctor can help you with both pre-existing health conditions and new changes to your health.



Here are a few details about the program:

- The program is **optional** and voluntary.
- The on-site doctor will provide full family doctor services.
- To participate in the program, residents must transfer their care from their current family doctor to the on-site doctor.

Why participate?

Having an on-site family doctor supports your quality of medical care and can help improve your **overall health and quality of life**.

Care provided will be individual, **person-centered and culturally safe**.
