If you have any questions, ask anyone on the team.

When you leave P.A.T.H.

The team will plan with you and your family for your return to home or community.

You should make sure you take the following with you:

- All personal items
- Medications from home and new prescriptions
- Dates and referrals for follow-up appointments

You or your family are responsible for making follow-up appointments.
