What is Mission Rapid Response?

Provides home visits by a registered nurse for the urgent care needs of frail seniors.

The registered nurses work closely with family doctors and other home health professionals to help meet the care needs of frail seniors in their homes.

This service is available 5 days a week from 8:30_{AM} to 4:30_{PM}. A home visit will be made within 24 hours.

This service is covered under your BC Medical Service Plan.

Who can receive this service?

You can receive this service if...

- You live in Mission and have difficulty leaving your home
- You are currently receiving services from Mission Home Health
- You have a health care need that a nurse can help with such as:
 - COPD flare-ups
 - heart failure exacerbation
 - urinary tract infections
 - changes to mental status or new confusion (delirium)
