## **Your child has been referred to our clinic to be assessed by a children's doctor (pediatrician).**

Our clinic is an outpatient clinic for children with medical concerns, or that require a test, procedure and IV Therapy or dressing change.

### **Appointment Times**

We will call you by telephone tomorrow morning before 10:00 a.m. to book your child's appointment.

Appointment times are between 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. but could be later.

#### **If you do not receive a call by 10:00 a.m.**

Call the number on the back of this pamphlet to schedule the appointment.

### **What to bring**

Bring your child's BC Care Card.  
(personal health number)

### **Directions**

- Take the elevator to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.
- Turn right off the elevator.
- Follow signs for 2NB Pediatric Unit.
- Check in at the reception desk.

## **What happens during my child's appointment?**

The doctor assesses your child for the medical concern they were referred to the clinic. If you have other concerns about your child's health, the doctor will advise and/or refer you to health services in your community.

## **How long will I have to wait?**

Your wait time could be longer than expected. This is a hospital setting and emergencies can happen at any time.

The time you spend at the clinic will depend on your child's medical concern, and if they need any tests or treatments.

## **Going Home**

Your child stays on the Pediatric Unit until the doctor decides your child is okay to go home.

Before you leave, we give you information on:

- how to care for your child at home
- any follow up appointments if needed
