

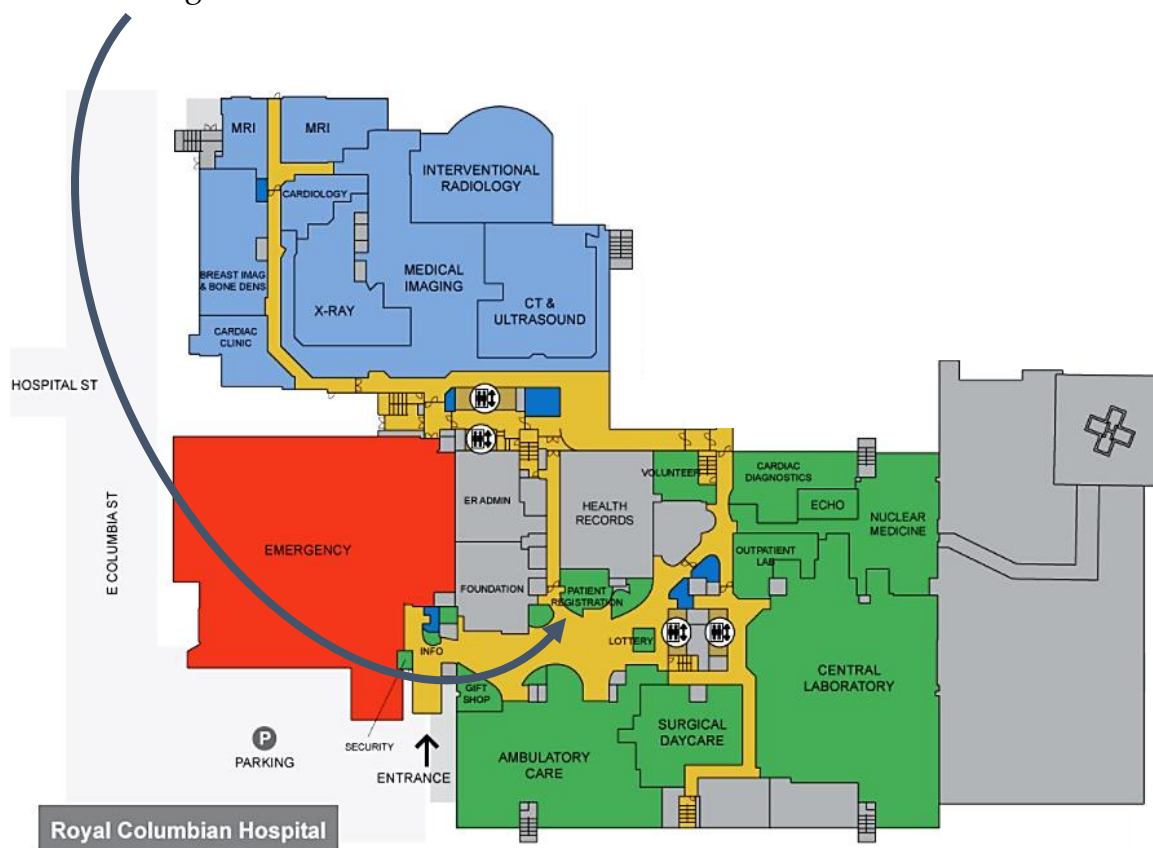

## Where to go – Royal Columbian Hospital

330 East Columbia Street  
New Westminster, B.C.

Report to **Patient Registration** at your 'Check-in Time'.

Patient Registration is located in the **Health Care Centre Green Zone**.



## Level 1 Map

Our registration clerk places 2 wristbands on your wrist.

- A hospital wristband tells us who you are.
- A wristband with digital sensor tells us where you are in your surgical journey. Knowing where you are helps each location on your journey be ready for you.

# Surgical Journey Board for people having surgery

**Patient:** For privacy, we hide the person's name.

- We show the first 2 letters and last letter of the last name, and first letter of the first name. For example, **Berinder Lal** shows as **La...I, B.**
- Names are in alphabetical order by last name.

Time the person entered **Pre-Operative Care** to wait for surgery.

Time the person entered the operating area for **Surgery**.

Time the person entered **Post-Anesthetic Recovery** to be closely monitored after

## Visiting

If the location allows visiting, the letter V appears on the board when the person is ready for visiting. Please tell staff at the location's nursing station who you are visiting.

Time the person entered the **Final Recovery** area to finish recovering.

**Departure Destination:** Time the person leaves the final recovery area. These include:

- Home: Person has gone home.
- Hospital Location: Person has gone to a bed in the hospital (see table on the left).
- Other: Person has gone to an area not listed in the table on the left.
