## Urgent and Primary Care Centres

Timely care for urgent, non-life-threatening illnesses and injuries.





**Urgent and Primary Care Centres (UPCCs)** are here if you cannot see your family

provider or do not have one.

- Consider visiting a UPCC if you have:
  - Skin, sinus or lung infections
  - New wounds, including burns
  - New or worsening pain

Cuts that need stitches

- New constipation or diarrhea
- New pain or burning when peeing





You will be assessed on the telephone or when you arrive by a registered nurse. Patients are seen based on urgency of care required.

You may be seen by a member of the care team.

- Family doctor/ Nurse practitioner
- Nurse
- Clinical pharmacist
- Social worker
- Clinical counsellor





UPCCs may also connect you to the right community services, including walk-in clinics.
