


Urgent and Primary Care Centres

Timely care for urgent, non-life-threatening illnesses and injuries.



Urgent and Primary Care Centres (UPCCs) are here if you cannot see your family provider or do not have one.

Consider visiting a UPCC if you have:

- ▶ Cuts that need stitches
- ▶ Skin, sinus or lung infections
- ▶ New wounds, including burns
- ▶ New or worsening pain
- ▶ New constipation or diarrhea
- ▶ New pain or burning when peeing



You will be assessed **on the telephone** or **when you arrive** by a registered nurse. Patients are seen based on urgency of care required.

You may be seen by **a member of the care team.**

- ▶ Family doctor/ Nurse practitioner
- ▶ Nurse
- ▶ Clinical pharmacist
- ▶ Social worker
- ▶ Clinical counsellor



UPCCs may also connect you to the right **community services**, including walk-in clinics.
