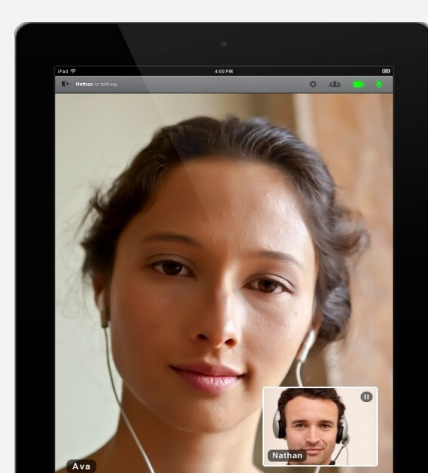

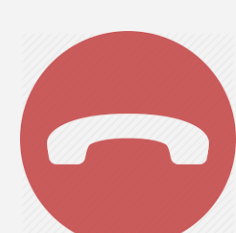

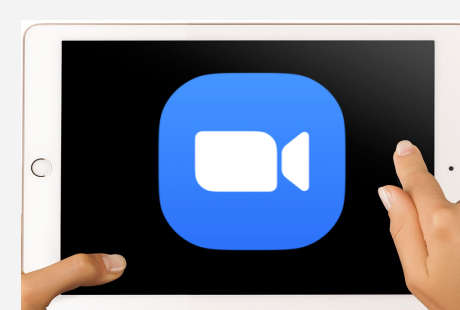

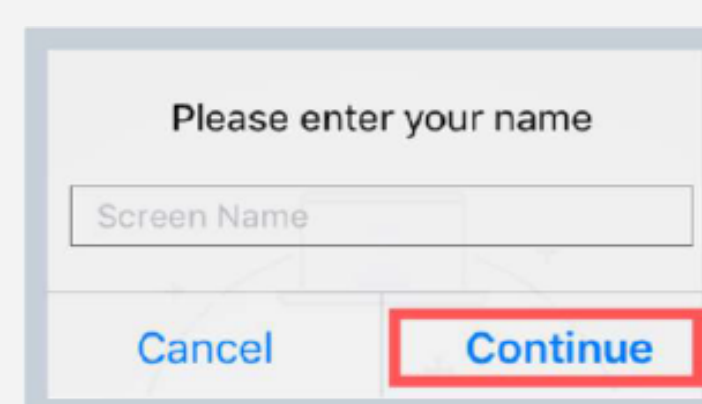
4 Join a Scheduled Video Visit

Zoom icon



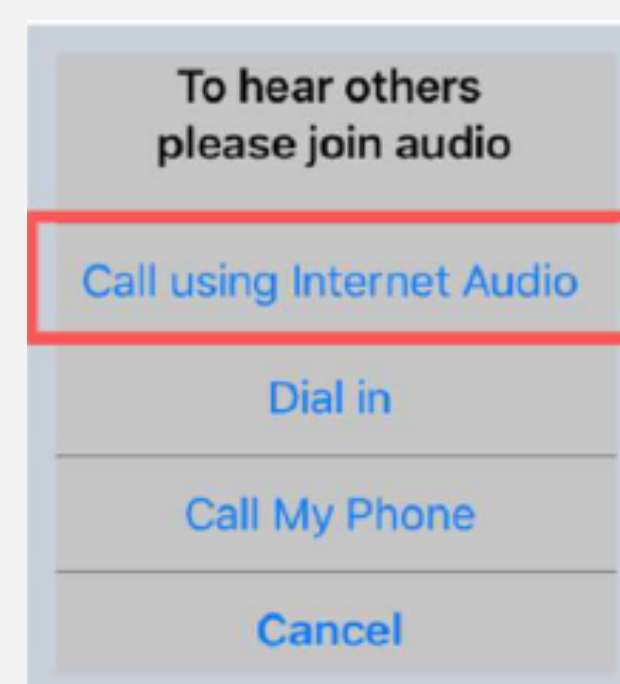
Tap on **meeting link**

your care provider

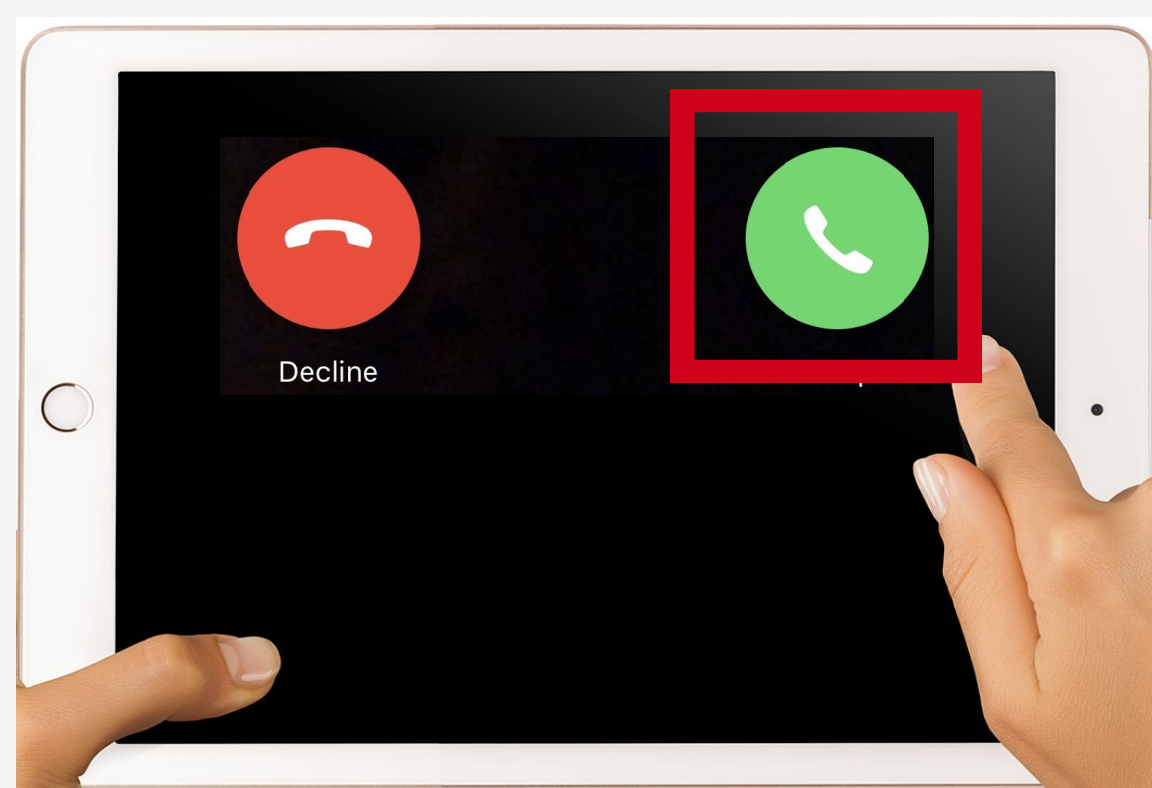


Tap on the **leave icon**

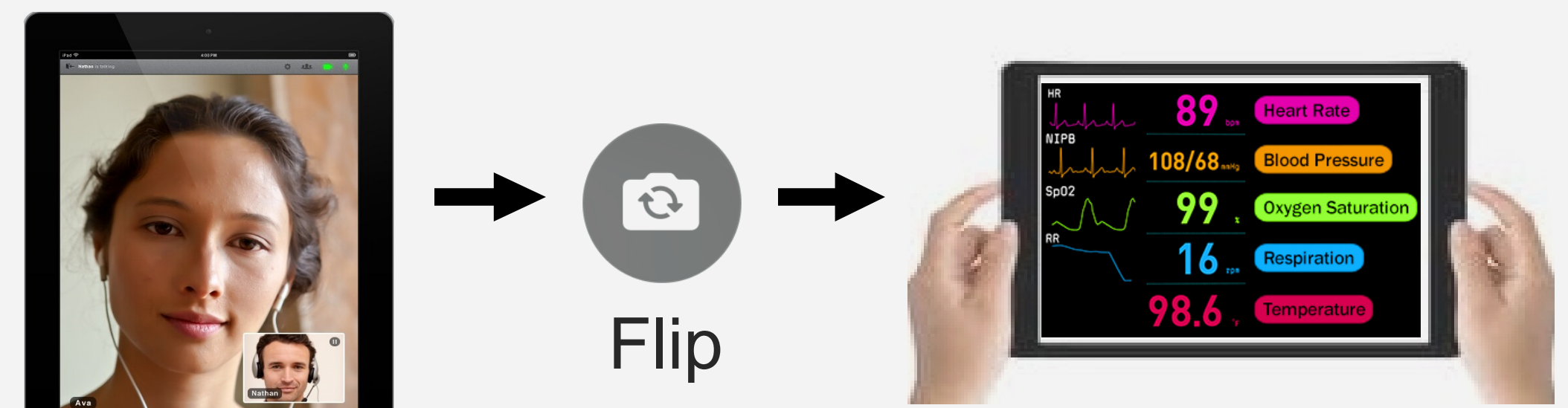
Answering a Video Call

tap on the **flip** button and point the iPad

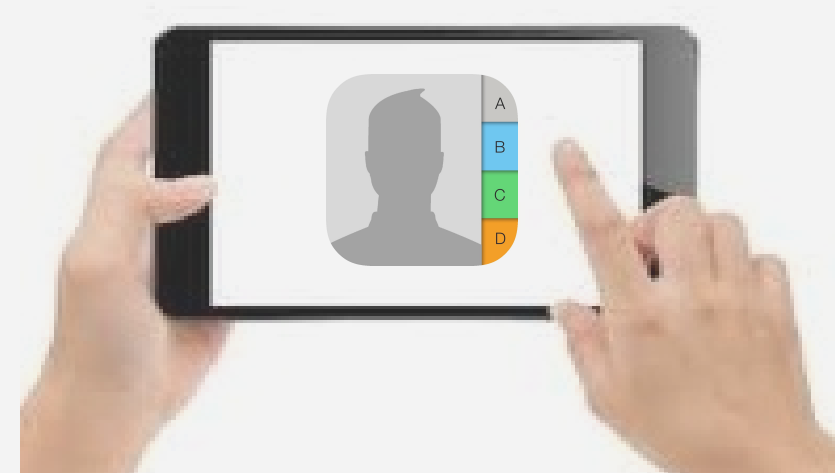


Tap on the red **end call** button when you and

Before Starting a Video Call

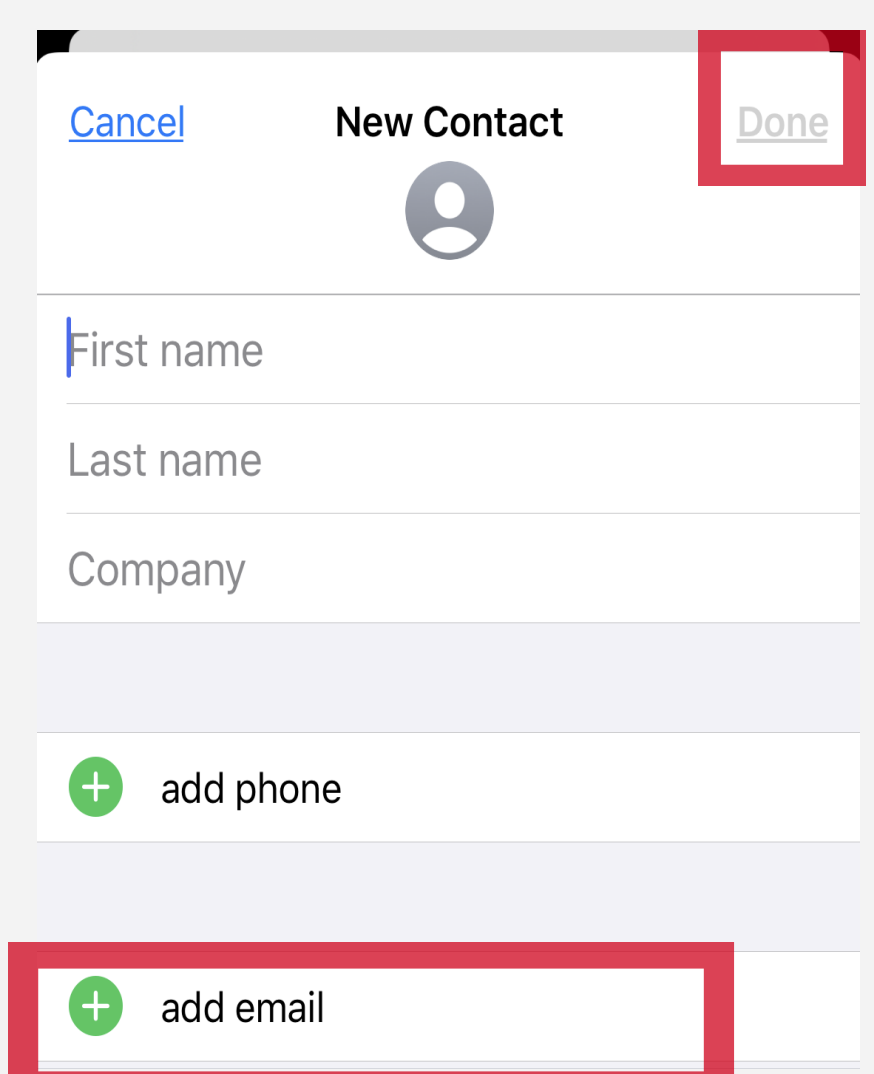
Add the contact to the contact list,



Tap the **Contacts** icon



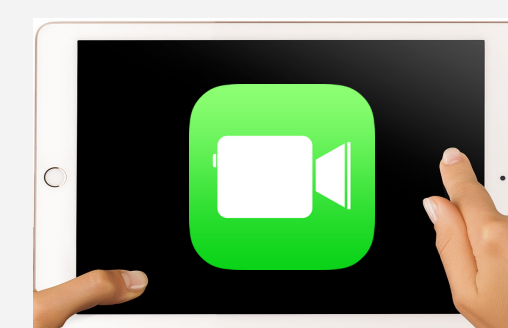
Tap on the **+** sign
to create a new contact



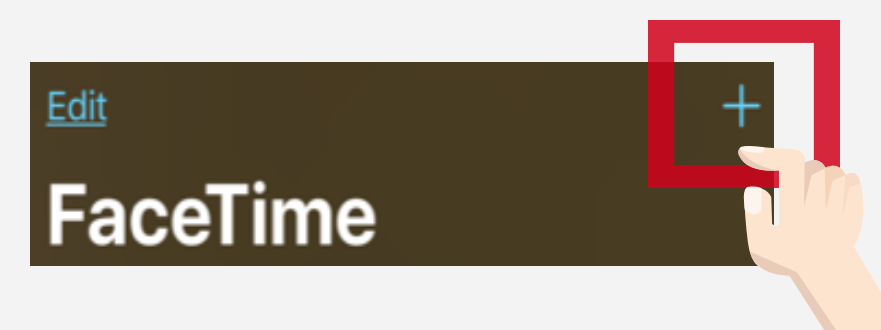
Enter your provider's

(on the top right corner)

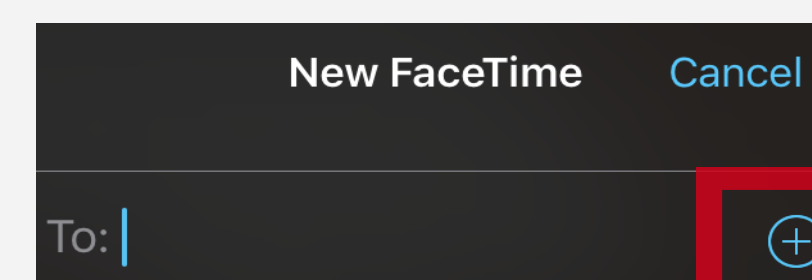

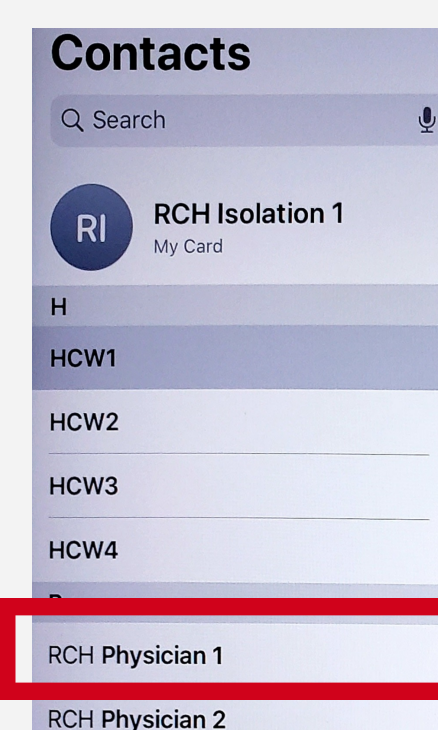
