### Communicable Disease Control

---

Public health nurses are responsible for the control of communicable and infectious diseases.



- Regular immunizations for children and adults
- Prevention through education and counselling
- Follow-up of communicable diseases

### Child and Family Health

---

Public health nurses help to ensure the basic needs of children and families.

- Pregnancy health and prenatal classes
- Prenatal breastfeeding class
- Postnatal phone calls and home visits
- Postnatal support groups and classes
- Community resources information
- Breastfeeding support clinics
- Parenting programs



## North Surrey Public Health



### School Age Health

---

Healthy children learn better.

- In school immunizations
- Emergency preparedness
- Support and education regarding health concerns



### Adult Health

---

Public health nurses help promote optimal health in the adult population.

- Education on health related issues
- Flu clinics
- Sexually transmitted infections clinic
- Tuberculosis (TB) skin testing and follow-up as required
- Links with senior centres and programs
- Links with women's health clinics, substance abuse support and emergency shelters



### Dental Varnish Clinics

---

Prevention and maintenance of children's dental health.

- Family dental referrals
- Free fluoride varnish application to prevent cavities for children who do not have a dentist for regular care
